Herbicide Resistance





PPO inhibitors

- WSSA MOA #14
- Valor, Cobra, Ultra Blazer
- Already reported in 12 states
 - Palmer amaranth
 - tall waterhemp
 - common ragweed


VLCFA inhibitors

- WSSA MOA #15
- Dual Magnum, Warrant
- Only 1 case reported in US
 - Italian ryegrass (Idaho)








Organicfood
