

Peanut Leadership Academy Application 2021-23 – Class XII

Program Objective

To provide intensive training opportunities, develop and improve leadership skills and industry understanding for Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Texas and Virginia peanut growers, as well as sheller representatives.

Sponsorship

The Peanut Leadership Academy is an education project coordinated by the Southern Peanut Farmers Federation and sponsored by Syngenta Crop Protection and the American Peanut Shellers Association.

Curriculum

Activities are structured to give participants a thorough understanding of the United States peanut industry. Participants spend approximately 20 days participating in field trips, meetings with industry leadership and professional development training concentrated in the following program areas: government affairs, peanuts & international markets, policy development, professional development, research and marketing, and U.S. peanut industry.

Eligibility Requirements

Candidates must:

- 1) Derive their primary livelihood from farming and currently produce peanuts.
- 2) Preferably be between the ages of 22 and 45 on or before July 1, 2021.
- 3) Make a commitment to the Peanut Leadership Academy and agree to attend all sessions (approximately 20 days of travel), except in time of illness or family emergency.
- 4) Provide a completed application.

Cost to Participate

Participants cover local transportation to and from meetings (i.e. transportation to airport and to local events), as well as occasional meals.

Program Calendar

There are approximately five sessions throughout a two-year period. Session dates & activities are finalized at least 60 days to departure. Times and dates below are tentative and may be changed.
